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
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**Editorial.....**

Taking in consideration its subjects the papers this preliminary screening very manuscript submitted for publication is read at least by the editor, for an initial review and will be remitted to a panel to referees involved in those research areas. They can be either external or members of the editorial Board, through always chosen by their recognised expertise. Each paper will be reviewed by two referees.

After evaluation the referees involved in those reports about the works reviewed by which the papers can be:

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2. Approved as they are
3. Rejected from the start. In case that the papers proposed are accepted but in need of modifications or corrections the editors will return the manuscripts to the authors, together with the referee's reports and all the suggestions, recommendations and comments therein.

To secure impartiality during the review process, all papers, as remitted to the referees, will be anonymous. Moreover, the referees, identities will not be known, neither by the rest of the evaluation panel, nor by the authors.

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
